Maintenance:

- This week, many homeowners picked up the White "no Service" flags from the Lodge. We want to thank everyone for placing them in your yard.
- Next week, 6/20 6/24, the Grounds & Assets Committee and Ross Broadway, Brightview Acct. Mgr., have decided that there will be no mowing. The service team will still be on-site pruning, working on detailing beds, and mowing the Bush Hog areas.

Pruning:

- We will be continue pruning on Humphrey's Glen and Del Webb Blvd. on Monday June 20th.
- We will be focusing on the evergreen shrubs (i.e., hollies, boxwoods, Loropetalum, Clereya). We will spot pruning the flowering shrubs like Spirea and Abelia for tall shoots, they are not trimmed for shape during the growing season. Roses will not be pruned this time of year.
- o If you have a red magnet, we will not be pruning your home.

Irrigation:

 Irrigation is not a substitute for rainfall. Fescue turf grass will go dormant the hotter the temperatures get.
