- Pump 2 currently is not working. The lake levels have contributed to a problem with the pump. We are working with Management and the HOA to repair it.
- Please remember to check your rain sensors on your Irrigation system to make sure you they are working properly.
- The US Drought Monitor still has Maury County in Moderate to Abnormally Dry.

- With the high humidity that has returned to the area we are starting to see more instances of Brown Patch.

- The spray is more of a spot treatment and the granular is a preventive treatment that works long term in the soil. Please remember to read the instruction before using them.

Turf Application:

- We will be retreating the parkways Thursday for grassy weeds.
- Round 4 Turf Application will begin Mid-August. This will be another Weed treatment and Fertilizer to get ready for Aeration and Over-Seeding.
