

### Weekly Plans and Notes (05/24 – 05/28)

- **Rain:** After 14 days with little to no precipitation we have finally gotten some rain! The rain gauge is sitting at .72 inches for Friday 05/28.
- **Irrigation:** Remember when setting your Irrigation Systems, this is not a “Set and Forget” System! That means making weekly changes to your system can have great effects in how your turf looks and the amount of water that it uses. Spring Hill has been out shutting off certain water meters due to high usage. Making adjustment to water deeply and less often can help set your turf up for success in drought conditions and help curb your usage as well.
- **Maintenance:** This week we were able to follow the schedule but found we will have to make a few adjustments to the posted schedule. This way we can be as accurate as possible. These adjustments will continue as new homes are added.
  - **Edging:** We will be edging the Beds next week.
- **Pruning:** This week we were able to complete the pruning along Carter Court & Trail, Wilson Springs & Park, Overton East, Tipton Pass, Picket Place, Clay Court & Place (to Shelby Springs Park), and Shelby Springs & Park. We will be following the schedule below for the next few weeks.
