- **Rain:** Wednesday Southern Spring received 1.76 inches of rain over a 24 hour period.
- **Irrigation:** Remember when setting your Irrigation Systems, this is not a “Set and Forget” System! That means making weekly changes to your system can have great effects in how your turf looks and the amount of water that it uses. With the 1.76 inches of rain we had it is ok to check your systems and make sure that the Rain Sensor is working.
- **Maintenance:** This week was a tough week. With Memorial Day on Monday and then a rain out Wednesday, we are working diligently to get the homes completed. If we do not complete a street this week, we will complete it first next week. We will be behind on the schedule next week because we will be mowing the Parkways and Lodge, before starting the next rotation.
 - **Edging:** We will be edging the Concrete next week.
- **Pruning:** This week we were able to complete the pruning on Clay Place and Franklin Springs and Park. The following schedule is the plan for the next 2 weeks. Remember we are also pruning the evergreen shrubs allowing the flowering shrubs time to flower.
