

Weekly Plans and Notes (05/24 – 05/28)

- **Weather:** June's average rainfall 3.8 inches. In the first 11 days of the month we have received 3.03 inches at Del Webb.
 - **Brown Patch:** The weather conditions are right for the formation of turf diseases like Brown Patch. Last year it was noticed throughout the community. Please remember that High Heat, High Humidity and High Water usage are the main contributors to turf diseases and you only have control over one. If you start to see it show up at most Hardware Stores you can pick up a fungicide treatment.



- **Irrigation:** Remember when setting your Irrigation Systems, this is not a “Set and Forget” System! That means making weekly changes to your system can have great effects in how your turf looks and the amount of water that it uses. Please make sure that the Rain Sensor is working in order to help save on watering. Fescue only needs 1 inch of water every 7 days to maintain good turf health, the weather has got you covered.
- **Maintenance:** This week we delayed starting on Wednesday 2 hours and Friday morning as well. We will be in on Saturday to finish up. We will be back our schedule now that the weather is finally clearing up.
 - **Edging:** We will be edging the Beds next week.
- **Turf Application:** The third round of turf application is being scheduled. It will begin near the first of July.

- Pruning:** This week we were able to complete the pruning on Davidson Walk, Coffee Ridge, Humphrey's Glen, Bledsoe & Park, Del Webb, Cannon Ln, Grainger Springs, Fayette Court, and Gibson Trail & Park. The following schedule is the plan for the following week. Remember we are pruning the evergreen shrubs allowing the flowering shrubs time to flower.
