

### Weekly Plans and Notes (07/12 – 07/16)

- **Weather:** Since last Friday we have received 2.12 inches of rain. This has helped us recover from the dry spell a couple of weeks ago and has brought us to 4.76 inches for the month of July. This is a .25 inches higher than July's Average Rainfall.
  - The Conditions are again right for Brown Patch to form. Please be aware of when you water and how much water you are watering.
- **Irrigation:** Remember irrigation is a supplement to rainfall not a replacement of it.
  - Tip: Adjusting the seasonal setting on your Controller ups the watering time on ALL zones. When you may just need to adjust the time in one zone.
  - Please if you see a zone running for an area getting irrigated for a long period of time please reach out to us on Town Square (under COS Irrigation).
- **Maintenance:** This week we have been rained out Monday and Tuesday afternoons. We did not start on the homes until Wednesday afternoon with the Estates. We have mowed the East side of Del Webb Thursday and Friday. We will start mowing the West Del Webb on Monday. I will post an updated schedule on Monday morning.
  - **Edging:** We will be edging the concrete next week.
  - **Bush Hogging:** We have started bush hogging the designated areas throughout the community. Please be careful and do not walk in these areas. They are not finished graded and they also have ticks and other wildlife.
- **Turf Application:** The third round of turf application is has been scheduled. It will begin near the 26<sup>th</sup> of July. We pushed it back to allow the turf to recover from the short drought we had.
- **Pruning:** We will be pruning the Model village and the islands next week.
