

## Weekly Plans and Notes (07/19 – 07/23)

- **Weather:** Monday morning we received another inch of rainfall. Spring hill is now at 6 inches for the month of July. This is a 1.5 inches higher than July's Average Rainfall.
  - The Conditions are again right for Brown Patch to form. Please be aware of when you water and how much water you are watering.
- **Irrigation:**
  - Tip: With this much rainfall make sure that your rain sensor is working correctly and that it is not watering for the allotted time.
  - Please if you see a zone running for an area getting irrigated for a long period of time please reach out to us on Town Square (under COS Irrigation).
- **Maintenance:** This week we were rained out Monday. We used that day to Prune the entrance and work on details down the main parkway. We did not start on the homes until Tuesday morning. We finished all the homes that had not been completed last week first. Next week we will be working with Weed Man as they apply Round 3 treatment.
  - **Edging:** We will be edging the concrete next week.
  - **Bush Hogging:** We finished with the main bush parts and will be wrapping up the smaller areas in the next 2 weeks. Please be careful and do not walk in these areas. They are not finished graded and they also have ticks and other wildlife.
- **Turf Application:** The third round of turf application starts next week. We will begin with the East Side of Del Webb Blvd. This is because they were mowed on Friday and we will have to be off them for 2 days after treatment. This will allow us to get ahead of Weed Man for the remainder of the week.
- **Pruning:** Next week we will be pruning the flowering shrubs and spot pruning throughout the homes. I will be posting the schedule on Monday morning to Town Square.
