

### Weekly Plans and Notes (8-10 through 8-15)

- **Mowing:** This week our mowing crews started at Carter Trail and the Estates. Both crews worked up through the neighborhoods in their respective areas. We are onsite today (Saturday) wrapping up the mow along Southern Springs Pkwy. We edged Beds this week.
  - **Next Week:** We will start Monday back on the homes, beginning at the Estates and Carter Trail. We will mow all the parkways and the Lodge, later in the week, once the homes are completed. We will edge curbs/driveways/sidewalks next week.
  
- **Pruning:** We pruned around the newer section of Overton as well as worked down Lawrence Ridge.
  - **Next Week:** We will prune down the rest of Lawrence Ridge, then Madison, Henderson and Loudon Hill.
  
- **Irrigation:**
  - Concrete got delayed along Southern Springs parkway and we are waiting to hear back from that contractor on when they can do it.
  - If anything is running during the day, then that is our irrigation tech doing a system check. If a zone seems to run for more than an hour, there is probably an issue and please report that to us, via TownSq.
  - Coffee Ridge: The recharge system is fully operational now and running every day for approximately 10 hours. This may change depending on what other repairs are going on around the area each day, but its programed to run daily.
  - There is also a small leak along Southern Springs, at the entry to Tipton. This has been leaking for a week or so, but in order to repair it we will have to shut down a very large part of the system and cut the sidewalk again. This water is coming from the Lake, so it's not costing the HOA any water bills with the leak. We plan to start this repair on Monday, now that the temperatures have cooled off and we got some rain.

**Turf Re-treatment:** We asked TruGreen to come back out this week and they had someone out all week spot spraying around the COS areas and homes where they didn't get good control from the last treatment. They will still return in a few weeks to complete the Round 4 application as well.
