

Weekly Plans and Notes (08/23 – 08/27)

- **Insect Alert:** I want to thank everyone for being so proactive with treating for the Armyworms. I have not seen very many active worms this last week and I know that many of you were treating again this weekend. We may be out of the worst of the infestation, but please be vigilant over the next week couple of weeks. Also next year we will need to be ready to retreat in case of they return.

- **Turf Application:** Last week we began Round 4 application at Southern Springs. The treatment is for broadleaf weeds and grassy weeds. The Chemicals will effect each weed differently. Broadleaf should show signs as early of dying as early as 5 days. The Grassy weeds will take 10 - 14 days and these weeds will change color to a yellowish green then to a white color.
 - **Thursday Broadleaf:** Carter Court, Carter Trail, Pickett, Overton (east), Tipton Pass, Shelby Springs, Clay Place(from Shelby Springs to Franklin Springs), Franklin Springs (east), Davidson Walk, Coffee Ridge. **Not Treated:** Clay Place from Shelby Springs to Clay Court. **Will Be Treated Monday 8/30**
 - **Friday Grassy Weeds:** Carter Court, Carter Trail, Pickett, Overton (east), Shelby Springs, Tipton Pass, Clay Place (Overton to Franklin Spring - Clay Place that backs up to Pickett). **Not Treated:** Coffee Ridge, Davidson Walk, Franklin Springs, Clay Court, Clay Pace (odd Homes from Overton to Clay Court) **Will Be Treated Monday 8/30**

- **Maintenance:** Last week we were able to get everything mowed in preparation for Weed man. We mowed first, the East Side of Del Webb and then the West side. This week since treatment did not go as planned we will Start in the Estates then mow the West Side of Del Webb. That way they can be treated this week.
 - **Edging:** We will be edging the Beds next week.
 - **Next week (9/7 – 9/11):** We will be **LOWERING** the mower height to start getting ready for Aeration and Over-seeding

- **Aeration and Over-Seeding:** Aeration and Over-Seeding will be starting in September. Please, remember we will not be mowing for 14 days after we Aerate and Over-Seed your street.
