

## Weekly Plans and Notes (9-7 through 9-12)

- **Mowing:** This week our mowing crews started back at Carter Trail and the Estates. Both crews worked up through the neighborhood in their respective areas. We finished the homes on DWB and Bledsoe today (delayed mowing day for TG treatment), along with the rest of the parkway and Lodge. We edged beds this week. All weekly mowing will be completed today.
  - **Next Week:** We will start Monday back on the homes, beginning at the Estates and Carter Trail. We will mow all the parkways and the Lodge, later in the week, once the homes are completed. We will edge curbs/driveways/sidewalks next week.
- **Bed Weeds:** We have been spraying around the homes at Carter Trail and Court, Tipton, Shelby Springs, Wilson Springs, and Overton (east side). We also worked on a few COS areas well.
  - We are also cleaning up the Estates buffer some more today and will be spraying the bed weeds even more next week as well.
- **Irrigation:** If anything is running during the day, then that is our irrigation tech doing a system check. If a zone seems to run for more than an hour, there is probably an issue and please report that to us, via TownSq.
  - There is another leak along the main parkway, but we have isolated it so the rest of the system can run.
- **Turf Applications:** TruGreen has been onsite all week treating for turf weeds and applying fertilizer. They will be back tomorrow and next week to finish the following areas.
  - Clay Place/Court, Carter Trail, Pickett, Overton (east side), Franklin Springs, Coffee Ridge, Humphreys Glenn, Davidson Walk and Grainger Springs.

### Upcoming Services:

- **Aeration and Overseeding:** We plan to start on the 21<sup>st</sup>, with the main parkways and then move into the homes after that. It will take 3-4 weeks to complete the whole site.
  - Once your yard is aerated/seeded, it will be skipped the following week to allow the seed to settle and germinate.
- **Fall Pinestraw:** the Fall application will start on the week of Sept 21<sup>st</sup> as well and will take about 2-3 weeks to complete. This will be for all COS beds and homes
- **Fall Flowers:** The fall rotation of annual flowers will be in mid-late October.
