

Rain Gauge @ Lodge: 4.33" of rain during the day Sunday.

Weekly Plans and Notes (9-14 through 9-19)

- **Mowing:** This week our mowing crews were delayed on Monday due to the extreme rainfall we had on Sunday. Instead of mowing we trimmed, pulled weeds and cut down dead trees in the COS areas. Tuesday we started back mowing, but had to alter our schedule around where TruGreen was treating the turf. We wrapped up all the homes and the Parkways this afternoon. We have delayed the mowing at the Lodge by a few days to time up with A&O better. We edged curbs/driveways/sidewalks this week.
 - **Next Week:** We will start Monday back on homes, beginning at the Estates and Carter Trail, back to our normal rotation around the homes. Anything that we aerate this week will not be mowed for 10-14 days afterwards, to allow seed to germinate.
- **Bed Weeds:** We have been spraying around the parkway islands in prep for Pinestraw. We also re-sprayed the large buffer along Davidson Walk. Other areas that were sprayed this week are: Estates berm, homes on DWB, Tipton, Carter Trail, Overton (East) and the retaining wall edges along Overton (east).
- **Irrigation:** If anything is running during the day, then that is our irrigation tech doing a system check. If a zone seems to run for more than an hour, there is probably an issue and please report that to us, via TownSq.
 - The break along SS Parkway, across from the Models, is repaired and we will fill in the hole next week and have the concrete repaired again. When the concrete was poured, it cracked the fitting under that section of sidewalk, which is what cause the new leak.
- **Turf Applications:** TruGreen has been onsite all week treating for turf weeds and applying fertilizer. They have completed all areas as of today and also worked on some touchup areas from last week. Most dieback can take up to 10+ days to see results. We are monitoring dieback throughout and if we notice trouble areas we will touch up as we see them.

Upcoming Services (Next Week for A&O and Pinestraw):

- **Aeration and Overseeding:** We plan to start on Monday with the main parkways. We will follow in a similar rotation as we did with the last round of turf treatments. Once we get up the parkways, we will move over into the Estates and then along the homes on the West side of DWB. It will take 4+ weeks to complete the whole site.
 - It will take most of next week to complete the Entry and main parkways. The A&O process is much slower than the mowing.
 - Once your yard is aerated/seeded, it will be skipped the following week to allow the seed to settle and germinate. We will do our best to mow your home, then aerate within 1-2 days after that.
 - **Flagging AT&T lines:** we have been told by residents that the buried ATT cable are shallow in some areas and in years past have been cut by the aerators. We have no way to know where these buried cables are at, so if you are concerned about this, we recommend you place marking flags along the path of the buried lines. Our crews will then avoid that area with the machines.

- **Fall Pinestraw:** the Fall application will start next week and will take about 2-3 weeks to complete. This will be for all COS beds and homes. We will start on Tuesday at the front entry and then work up the parkways toward the back of the community. We will have a trailer of Pinestraw staged in the empty cul-de-sac of Fayette Ct.

- **Fall Flowers:** The fall rotation of annual flowers will be in mid-late October.
