- **Mowing:** This week concluded our last full mow of the year. We started mowing at Clay Ct, moving Up Clay to Shelby Springs, Tipton (Long Side). Clay Place, Franklin Springs, Davidson Walk, Coffee Ridge and Short Side of Humphrey's Glenn, the Sales Center, Model Homes and Entrance.
 - **Next Week:** With it being the week of Thanksgiving we will be mowing and mulching up leaves along the Parkways and at the Lodge.
- **Irrigation:** The COS Areas have been blown out and shut down for the season. There is still some new construction work on Irrigation along the West Side of Del Webb (along Knox and Loudon Hill) that will remain active for a while longer.
- **Pruning:** We will continue working on the COS areas for the next few weeks.
- **Turf Applications:** Your concerns have matched our own about the effectiveness of this year's Turf Treatments and we have taken steps to bring in a new vendor moving forward. They will be starting with this final Spot treatment for 2020 which will begin around Dec. 7th depending on weather conditions.
- **Leaf Management:** Over the next few weeks we will begin our leaf management of the property. Our focus will be on areas with high concentration of leaves down and we will move throughout the property as needed.
