

Weekly Update: May 16 - 20, 2022

Irrigation: With the current city mandate in place and with instructions from the HOA, we have turned off all irrigation throughout the community. The only zones running are those that cover the flower beds. We will continue to work with the HOA in following the city guidelines.

Maintenance:

- Next week we will be edging the Beds.
- We will continue to spray or pull weeds throughout the community.

Pruning:

- We will begin pruning the site the first week of June. I will have the schedule out next week. We have allowed all the shrubs to fully flush out along with the flowering shrubs.
- We will be focusing on the evergreen shrubs (i.e., hollies, boxwoods, etc.) We will also be Spot pruning the flowering shrubs to take off any tall lanky growth. (i.e., spirea, abelia, etc.)
- If you have a red magnet, we will not be pruning your home.
