

**Weekly Update: June 27<sup>th</sup> – July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**

**Maintenance:**

- Next week 7/5 – 7/8. With the temperatures continue to be in the middle 90's and no rainfall mowing is still not advised. We will be Edging the concrete and bed edges this week. We will not mow homes unless a homeowner calls the Lodge over the weekend.

**Pruning:**

- Next week we will be working detailing the homes in Phase 7. Any pruning that will be done will be with hand pruners only as all the plant material is still new.
- If you have a red magnet, we will not be pruning your home.

**Irrigation:**

- Irrigation is not a substitute for rainfall. Southern Springs has had less than 1.3 inches of rain for the entire month of June. Please remember, Fescue needs 1 inch of rain everyday 7 days to stay alive and not go dormant.
- Irrigation systems in the Community are a mixture of lake water and City water. If you live in Phases 4 and 5, the irrigation is on City water and subject to the city's guidelines. Pumps currently handle over 300 zones, and it takes 2 days to complete a water cycle.
